



PRESS RELEASE

MIAMI (United States) – The 2023-2027 electoral assemblies of FIBA's Central American & Caribbean Basketball Confederation (CONCENCABA), and its respective sub-zones, Central American Basketball Confederation (COCABA), and Caribbean Basketball Confederation (CBC) took place in Miami this past Monday February 13th, and concluded on Tuesday February 14th, with 30 National Federations (NFs) in attendance.

FIBA Authorities present during the assemblies included FIBA Secretary General, Mr. Andreas Zagklis, FIBA Treasurer Mr. Ingo Weiss, the President of FIBA in the Americas, Mrs. Carol Callan, and the Executive Director of FIBA in the Americas, Mr. Carlos Alves.

For the 23-member Caribbean Basketball Confederation (CBC), the regional governing body The assembly returned seven executive members, whose term of office comes into effect in May 2023.



At Large Members are: President of the Suriname Basketball Association-Mr. Conrad Issa (Suriname) and Mr. Marland Nattie (Jamaica). Aruba Basketball Bond Federation President-Mr. Kenneth Vrolijk from Aruba was elected Treasurer. The new Secretary is Ms. Velica Augustin from Saint Lucia. The Second Vice President is Mr. Junior Paez of the Dominican Republic, and the Third Vice President is Mr. Freddie Brown from the Bahamas. President of the St. Lucia Basketball Federation will be the first Vice President, but serve as Acting President.

Representing the Central American Confederation (COCABA), the President of the Asociación Deportiva Mexicana de Baloncesto, Mr. Modesto Robledo was elected as the new President. Mr. Ángel Mallona, President of the Nicaraguan Basketball Federation, will serve as first Vice President; while Mr. César Catalán of the National Basketball Federation of Guatemala, will be the Secretary.

Finally, for the Central American and Caribbean Confederation (CONCENABA), Mr. Patrick Haynes Secretary General of the Guyana Basketball Federation was elected President, he will be joined by Mr. Modesto Robledo and Mr. Leslie Collymore as first and second Vice-Presidents, respectively, and Mrs. Sabrina Mitchell will serve as Secretary.

The final regional electoral assembly for FIBA in the Americas will also be held in Miami, USA, from May 12-13, 2023.
